Installation Instructions

- Blue Ox® towing products and accessories are intended to be installed by Blue Ox® Dealers who are familiar with our products and have the equipment and knowledge to do "fit work." When necessary, Blue Ox® Dealers can be found at www.blueox.com or by contacting our Customer Care Department at (402) 385-3051.
- 2. Many Blue Ox® baseplates are designed to use existing holes and hardware to mount the baseplate to the towed vehicle. Even though bolts are there, do not assume they are adequate for baseplate mounting. Always use hardware supplied in the hardware kit or existing hardware specified in the Baseplate Towing Installation Instructions.

Confirm the towability and pre-towing procedures for your vehicle with the owner's manual or contact the vehicle's manufacturer for specific towing procedures.



Important:

Use only genuine factory replacement parts on your baseplate. Do **NOT** substitute homemade or non-typical parts. If a bolt is lost or in need of replacement, for your safety and the preservation of your baseplate, be sure to use a replacement bolt of the same grade (In most cases it will be Grade 5, please reference the parts list above). Replacement parts may be ordered through your nearest Blue Ox® Dealer or Distributor. Failing to follow and/or altering these installation instructions in either installation or required equipment will void the manufacturer's warranty.



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Vehicle Weight: Due to the design of the removable tabs, the RangeFinder II tow bar can not be used. Adapters, except the BX8833 and BX88151, can not be used with this baseplate.

Installation Notes: The fascia, temperature sensor, computer and washer reservoir are removed and reinstalled during installation of the baseplate. Drilling is required. Trimming is required.

The dimensional variations between otherwise identical vehicles can be considerable. While the baseplate was designed for easy installation, it may be necessary to tailor the baseplate slightly to compensate for auto manufacturer's tolerances. These minor adjustments may include filing a hole slightly, bending electrical rods or bending end plates.

The BX8848, 4 Diode wiring kit is recommended for this vehicle.

Handling of some cosmetic parts when installing this product may require the use of protective covers, rags, specialty tools, etc. to prevent damage.

Installation Instructions



 Using a 10MM socket remove the bolt above the headlight. Using a flat screwdriver remove the push pin. Do this to both sides and set bolts and push pins aside for later reinstallation.



Using a Phillips screwdriver, remove two

 screws just forward of the front tire on the wheel well. Do this to both sides of the vehicle. Set the screws aside to be reinstalled later.



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 Continuing just forward of the front tire on the wheel well, using an 10MM socket, remove the bolt in the corner. Do to both sides and set bolt aside for later reinstallation.



 On the driver side only in front of the tire, use a flat screwdriver to remove the push pin. Set the pin aside for later reinstallation.




 Using a flat screwdriver, remove four (4) push pins from underneath the front edge of the fascia. Set push pins aside to be reinstalled later.




Be sure to unplug the fog lights. The corner
of the fascia is then pulled out to the side and
forward to remove. Set fascia aside carefully
to be reinstalled later.




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


7. Using a utility knife, cut the plastic along the bottom of the bumper. Then using a flat screwdriver, remove the push pin. Do this to both sides. This section will not be reinstalled.



 On the passenger side, unclip the temperature sensor cord and unplug the sensor. Lay it over the top of the bumper.






9. On the driver's side right behind the bumper, using a 10MM socket remove two (2) bolts on the front and one on the back then let the computer hang down in order to do drilling. Set bolts aside to be reinstalled later.




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10. On the passenger side, using a 10MM socket, remove the two (2) bolts one on each side of the washer reservoir. Unplug the electrical plug and take the water lines off the washer reservoir, mark and plug them. Set washer reservoir and bolts aside to be reinstalled later.



11. Using a reciprocating saw, cut straight across right along side the bottom of the plate 3" and straight down at a 90° angle. (Flush with the lower frame extension and just behind the plastic.) Do this on both sides.




12. On the passenger side, cut off the bracket which held the temperature sensor. The temperature sensor will be relocated.




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13. On the backside of the fascia in the fog light area on the outer edge of the grille top opening, cut 1/2" in and straight to the side down to the first level. Do this on both sides.




14. Slide the baseplate up where we cut and back as far as it will go. Be sure the baseplate is level and clamp in place.



15. Using the baseplate as a template, drill six (6) holes with a 13/32" drill bit.


BE SURE TO USE LOCTITE® RED ON ALL BOLTS
BEFORE TIGHTENING. TIGHTEN ALL BOLTS
ACCORDING TO THE TORQUE CHART ON THE

16. On the passenger's side, the top two (2) bolts are brought from the inside out because of the black plastic shield. All the same 3/8"-16 x 1-1/4" hex bolts and 3/8"-16 hex nuts are used. Be sure to use Loctite Red on ALL bolts.




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
17. On the driver's side, mount the baseplate using 3/8"-16 x 1-1/4" hex bolts going in and 3/8-16 hex nuts. Be sure to use Loctite Red on ALL bolts.



19. Reattach the temperature sensor to the bracket mounted on the baseplate.




18. Attach the permanent baseplate safety cables to the provided convenience link on the baseplate (gray arrow). The photo above shows the recommended installation of the cables to frame of vehicle (see white arrow). Additional options may interfere with suggested mounting; in this case secure the cables to a solid piece of the frame as described in the instructions included with the permanent baseplate safety cables. Be sure the safety cables do not rub against any hoses or moving parts. Do this to both sides of the vehicle.




20. Reinstall the computer using the existing bolts, two (2) on the front and one on the back.




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21. Install the breakaway bracket in the middle of the passenger side. Using a 13/32" drill bit, drill through the underside of the bumper. Attach the bracket to the bumper with a 1/4"-20 x 2-1/4" hex bolt and a 1/4"-20 hex nut. Attach the breakaway to the bracket with a 1/4"-20 x 3/4" hex bolt and a 1/4"-20 hex nut.



23. On the backside of the fascia in the fog light area on the outer edge of the grille middle opening, cut 1/2" in and taper to the center. Do this on both sides.



22. Reinstall the washer reservoir, using all existing bolts.

Be sure that **ALL** electrical connections are plugged in properly and functioning **BEFORE** installing the fascia.

24. Replug the fog lights. Reinstall the fascia.

Install the tow bar and safety cables according to the instructions provided in their packages. When demonstrating this to the customer, be sure to include all the contents and packages.

Do NOT substitute other devices if the tow bar pins and clips are misplaced.
