

1. (4) 10mm bolts location



2. Remove the (4) 10mm bolts



3. (6) plastic clips location



4. Remove the (6) plastic clips



5. Remove the (10) plastic clips



6. Remove the plastic moulding



7. Remove the phillips head screw



8. Tug on the sides of the front bumper



9. Remove the front bumper



10. (5) plastic tabs location



11. Undo the mouting tabs



12. Remove the fog light hole cover



13. Cut the area marked




14. Cut the bumper



15. Bumper cut



16. Install the (2) spring nuts



17. Secure mouting bracket with (2) phillips head screws



18. Place the phillips screw in the fog light assembly



19. Place the fog light in the fog light hole



20. Tighten the phillips head screw



21. Remove the plastic clip



22. Remove the hood latch cover



23. Loosen the 10mm bolt




24. Secure the fog light harness ground wire to the 10mm bolt



25. Zip the fog light harness onto the factory harness



26. Replace the hood latch cover and the plastic clip



27. Remove the phillips head screw



28. Remove the lower dash board cover



29. Remove the dashboard under cover



31. Loosen the 10mm bolt




33. Cut a slit in the rubber grommet



30. Use the test light to locate the battery power line and the  $\ensuremath{\mathsf{ACC}}$  power line



32. Secure the switch harness ground wire with the 10mm bolt



34. Run the switch power wire through the rubber grommet



35. Zip the excess wire onto the factory wire harness



36. Replace the dashboard under the cover



37. Connect the switch harness to the fog light switch



38. Replace the dashboard and lower the cover



39. Tighten the phillips head screw



40. Pull the fog light switch power wire though the rubber grommet



41. Connect the extension wire to the switch power wire



42. Remove the (2) plastic clips



43. Remove the air duct cover



44. Connect the switch power wire extension to the fog light harness



45. Zip the switch power extension wire onto the factory wire harness



46. Replace the air duct cover and the (2) plastic clips




47. Connect the fog light harness to the fog light assembly



48. Replace the front bumper



49. Replace the (10) plastic clips



50. Tighten the (4) 10mm bolts and replace the (6) plastic clips Please repeat the steps in order from 1 to 50 for the opposite side



51. The installation now is complete
