**Baseplate Installation Instructions** 

Please read BOTH these Installation Instructions and the General Towing Instructions before attempting to install or operate this equipment.

- Blue Ox<sup>®</sup> towing products and accessories are intended to be installed by Blue Ox<sup>®</sup> Dealers who are familiar with our products and have the equipment and knowledge to do "fit work". When necessary, Blue Ox<sup>®</sup> Dealers can be found at www.blueox.com or by contacting our Customer Care Department at (888) 425-5382.
- Many Blue Ox<sup>®</sup> Baseplates are designed to use existing holes and hardware to mount the baseplate to the towed vehicle. Even though bolts are there, do not assume they are adequate for baseplate mounting. Always use hardware supplied in the hardware kit or existing hardware specified in the Baseplate Installation Instructions.

Confirm the towability and pre-towing procedures for your vehicle with the owner's manual or contact the vehicle's manufacturer for specific towing procedures.



#### **Important:**

Use only genuine factory replacement parts on your baseplate. Do **NOT** substitute homemade or non-typical parts. If a bolt is lost or in need of replacement, for your safety and the preservation of your baseplate, be sure to use a replacement bolt of the same grade (In most cases it will be Grade 5, please reference the parts list above). Replacement parts may be ordered through your nearest Blue Ox® Dealer or Distributor.

#### **Attachment Tabs:**

Motorhome mount tow bars are recommended for use with this baseplate. Due to the design of the removable tabs, the RangeFinderII, Adventurer, and Ambassador tow bars can not be used. The Acclaim tow bar may be used, but will not fold and store on the front of the vehicle. Adapters, except the BX8833 and BX88151, can not be used with this baseplate.

**Installation Notes:** The fascia and horn are removed for the baseplate installation. Trimming of the frame is required. Drilling is required.

The dimensional variations between otherwise identical vehicles can be considerable. While the baseplate was designed for easy installation, it may be necessary to tailor the baseplate slightly to compensate for auto manufacturer's tolerances. These minor adjustments may include filing a hole slightly, bending electrical rods, and/ or bending end plates.

The BX8869 Bulb and Socket Wiring Kit is recommended for this vehicle.

#### **Installation Instructions:**



 Remove seven bolts with a T20 Torx from across the top of the fascia (driver's side shown in photo). Set bolts aside to be reinstalled later.



 Just forward of the front tire, inside the wheel well, remove three bolts with a 7MM socket. Do this to both sides of the vehicle. Set bolts aside to be reinstalled later.



 Under the fascia remove the two pushpins in front of the tire. Do this to both sides of vehicle. Set pushpins aside to be reinstalled later.



4. In the middle under the fascia, remove the two clips by pushing the sides of the clip together with a small screw driver. Set the clips aside to be reinstalled later.



5. In front of the tire pull the wheel well cover back to remove the bolt with a 7MM socket. Do this on both sides. Set the bolt aside to be reinstalled later. Pull forward on the fascia to remove it, disconnect the turn signals and running lights (if applicable). Do this on both sides. Set the fascia aside carefully to be reinstalled later.



 On the driver's side, remove the two Christmas tree pins and unplug the horn. Using a 13MM socket, remove the two bolts (gray arrows). Set bolts aside to be reinstalled later.






7. Use a 10MM socket on the back to remove the bolt and horn. Set aside to be reinstalled later.


Using a good quality paint, spray cut edges of frame to prevent rusting.




9. On the passenger side, align the baseplate with the existing hole, be sure the baseplate is level and clamp in place with the large vice grips. Using the baseplate as a template, drill the additional three holes with the 13/32" drill bit. In order to protect the hoses, put a tube over the drill.



 Using a reciprocating saw, notch out the corner by measuring up from the bottom 1 1/4" and 1 1/4" across. Do this on both sides. We recommend painting the cut edges to prevent them from rusting.



10. On the driver's side, insure the baseplate is level with the frame and clamp in place with the large vice grips. Using the baseplate as a template, drill four holes into the frame with the 13/32" drill bit.



11. On the driver's side, install 3/8 x 1 1/2" bolts with 3/8" lock washers and tighten to 3/8-16 nut plates (white arrows). The top two nut plates are inserted from the front (see gray arrow on photo in step 8 for opening) and the bottom two are inserted from the bottom. Install the 1 x 1 1/2" spacer plate between the baseplate and the frame (gray arrow) and install 3/8 x 2" bolt with 3/8" lock washer and 3/8-16 nut plate. Use Loctite Red on all bolts.

BE SURE TO USE LOCTITE® RED ON ALL BOLTS BEFORE TIGHTENING. TIGHTEN ALL BOLTS ACCORDING TO THE TORQUE CHART ON THE FRONT PAGE OF THESE INSTRUCTIONS OR ON PAGE 3 OF THE BASEPLATE TOWING GENERAL INSTRUCTIONS.



13. Reinstall the horn and reconnect.



12. On the passenger side, install 3/8 x 1 1/2" bolts with 3/8" lock washers and tighten to 3/8-16 nut plates for the top two holes (white arrows). In the bottom two, install 3/8-16 x 2" bolts with 3/8" lock washers and tighten to 3/8-16 nut plates (gray arrows.)



14. Attach the permanent baseplate safety cables to the provided convenience link on the baseplate. The photo above shows the recommended installation of the cables to frame of vehicle. Additional options may interfere with suggested mounting; in this case secure the cables to a solid piece of the frame as described in the instructions included with the permanent baseplate safety cables. Be sure the safety cables do not rub against any hoses or moving parts. Do this to both sides of the vehicle.

15. Reinstall the fascia and reconnect all the lights. Be sure to reinstall all the bolts, clips and pins.

Install the tow bar and safety cables according to their instructions. When demonstrating this to the customer, be sure to include all of the Blue Ox packaging and contents.

**DO NOT** substitute other devices if the tow bar pins and clips are misplaced.

If the baseplate is in an accident, it must be replaced. DO NOT use it again! An accident can cause unseen damage and using it again could result in more damage or serious injury. DO NOT use the baseplate if it is damaged or missing parts. Be sure that **ALL** electrical connections are plugged in properly and functioning **BEFORE** Installing the fascia.
