



- Wash and dry your vehicle to remove any debris and/or dirt from the installation area.



Phillips Screwdriver 5/16" Socket wrench







- 1. Remove the 7 plastic clip from the from of grill (Fig 1)
- 2. Open the hood and remove the bolts on each side that hold the grill to the supports.(Fig 2)
- 3. Lower the hood carefully until it latches. Remove the grill by first lifting straight up and then pulling towards you.
- 4. Insert the grommet nuts into the slots in the hood where the outer tabs of the hood protector will mount.





- 5. Center the hood protector and fasten the outer mounting tabs to the hood .Using screws with washers going into the grommet nuts you placed in the hood.
- **6.** Re-install the grill to the hood using the clips & bolts you removed in step 1 and 2.

CLEANING YOUR HOOD PROTECTOR-USE ONLY SOAPY WATER AND A SOFT CLOTH. NEVER USE PAPER TOWELS, PETROLEUM PRODUCT, OR SOLVENTS TO CLEAN YOUR HOOD PROTECTOR.

PRODUCT CARE

- Periodically check the product to ensure all fasteners are tight and components are intact.
- Regular waxing is recommended to protect the finish of the product.
- Use ONLY Non-Abrasive automotive wax. Use of any soap, polish or wax that contains an abrasive is detrimental and Can scratch the finish leading to corrosion.

FAQ's

1. Mounting Bracket are not getting Installed properly.

In some cases Illustration images shown in Installation manual may not be the exactly same as per actual vehicle images ,also if Driver / Passenger side mounting brackets are very identical in the design, suggest referring Parts Identification guide to avoid fitment issue.

2. Products are thumping / rattling after installation.

Please ensure that all required mounting brackets / hardware's are installed & tighten correctly. Suggest using white lithium / regular grease between the metal to metal contact surfaces.

3. Missing / Excess Hardware.


Recheck hardware count as per the part list.

4. Product not installing properly.

Ensure make model year, cab length and bed size of your vehicle is listed in the application. All installation steps are followed correctly.
